

## Directions

The Coleshill Cycle Route is 33 miles in length and, where possible, uses quiet country roads. However, take extreme care, particularly at those points marked on the map . The route also includes a number of steep climbs only suitable for regular cyclists. The route is NOT signposted. Landranger maps 139 and 140 cover the route.

**1** Turn left out of Park Road Car Park and follow the road until it reaches the High Street. **Turn left** into High Street and then take the first right into Maxstoke Lane. Proceed out of Coleshill towards Maxstoke. Take the second **right** turn and proceed into the village. **Turn right** to Meriden. **Dismount at the A45 junction and cross with extreme care.** Continue to Meriden.

**2** Proceed to Meriden and cross the roundabout. Cycle through the village until you reach a mini roundabout. **Turn left** on to Showell Lane and then follow signs to Eaves Green. Continue along Lodge Green Lane until you reach the B4102. **Turn right**, following the signs for Fillongley. At the crossroads **turn right** into the village of Fillongley on the B4098.

**3** Continue for one mile to Corley and **turn left** opposite the Saracens Head Public House. Proceed down Highfield Lane until you reach a T junction. **Turn left** to Astley. Continue for 1/4 mile then **turn left** into Breach Oak Lane. Proceed for two miles to a T junction. **Turn left** and head for Astley. Go straight over the crossroads. One mile further on **turn left** at the T junction and head towards Annsley. **Take the second exit**, the B4112, at the roundabout and go through Annsley. Leave the village and at the T junction **turn right** on to the B4114.

**4** Proceed for one mile and **turn left**, into Pipers Lane, and cycle to Ridge Lane. **Turn left** at the White Hart Public House and immediately on the right **take the bridleway** through Bentley Woods. At the end of the path, opposite the Horse and Jockey Public House, **turn left** on to the B4116. After four miles go straight across the crossroads at Furnace End. Continue through Shustoke and past the Plough Inn Public House.

**5** Two miles from Shustoke is Coleshill. Cross over the crossroads and, after the Bell Public House, **turn left** and return to the car park.
