


Directions

The Kingsbury Cycle Route is approximately 35 miles in length and, where possible, uses quiet country roads. However, extreme care should always be taken, particularly at the points marked on the map . The route includes a number of steep climbs only suitable for regular cyclists. The route is not signposted. Landranger maps 139 and 140 cover the route.

1 Pear Tree Avenue Car Park. Turn **left** from the car park and **left** again onto the B4098. Upon leaving Kingsbury, take the third exit at the roundabout, the A4097. At the next roundabout turn **left**, Coton Road, towards Whitacre Heath. Proceed through Whitacre Heath, over the railway bridge, then turn **left** towards Shustoke.

2 At the T junction turn **left** to Shustoke, the B4114, then **right** to Maxstoke. Proceed towards Maxstoke, turn **left** and then **right**, and after one mile follow the road to the **left** as it enters the village. Continue out of Maxstoke towards Fillongley.

3 At the T junction, turn **left** onto the B4102. At the crossroads turn **left** on to the B4098. After approx one mile turn **right** towards Old and New Arley. Proceed to Old Arley, past the Wagon Load of Lime Public House and out of the village. At the T junction turn **left** and then **left** again on to the B4114.

4 After a short distance turn **right** towards Birchley Heath. Proceed through Birchley Heath to Ridge Lane. Just before reaching the White Hart Public House turn **left** on to a bridleway through Bentley Woods. At the end of the bridleway, opposite the Horse and Jockey Public House turn **right** on to the B4116, then **left** towards Baxterley.

5 Turn **left** on to Main Road and continue through the village and head towards Wood End. After 2 miles reach a T junction and turn **right** to Wood End. Proceed through Wood End, then turn **left** at Trinity Road to Kingsbury. Stay on this road until you reach Kingsbury. Turn **left** on to Pear Tree Avenue and your starting point at the car park.
