**MANDATORY CONDITIONS**

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence:
  - a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
  - b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

**CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE**

Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied except during permitted hours. In this condition permitted hours means-

- a) On weekdays, other than Christmas Day, 08:00 – 23:00
- b) On Sundays, other than Christmas Day, 10:00 – 22:30
- c) On Christmas Day, 12:00 – 15:0 and 19:00 – 22:30
- d) On Good Friday, 08:00 – 22:30

The above restrictions do not prohibit –

- a) During the first 20 minutes after the hours, the taking of alcohol from the premises unless the alcohol is supplied or taken in open containers
- b) The ordering of alcohol to be consumed off the premises or the despatch by the vendor of alcohol so ordered.
- c) The sale or supply of alcohol to any canteen or mess being a canteen in which the sale or supply of alcohol is carried out under the authority of the Secretary of State or an authorised mess of members of Her Majesty's Naval, Military or Air Forces.
- d) The sale of alcohol to a trader or club for the purposes of the trade or club.

Alcohol may only be served for consumption off the premises.
