CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE

- (a) Good management and control towards customers who are normally regular to this takeaway. Any disturbances will be reported immediately to the owner of the shop Mr Ng, who is always at the shop during opening hours.
- (b) There is no major incident in the past relating to crime and disorder in this premises. However co-ordination among the staff in the premises to be more vigilant and control any misunderstanding or even a beginning of an argument between customers or staff. This will prevent any disorder or any incident in the premises.
- (c) A telephone book with all emergency telephone numbers is clearly accessible in case of any emergency due to fighting. We have wide access to the entrance to the building, together with all access throughout the premises in case of fire. All staff will be trained to orderly disperse the customers in the shop, should there be an emergency, to lead them to the car park in front of the shop or the workers to be led away from the back of the kitchen area onto the back yard of the premises.
- (d) Customers who are named or identified as trouble makers will be banned from purchasing in the shop for a period of, initially, 2 months. After the initial 2 months, the persons involved, if he continues to behave badly, will be banned indefinitely from the shop.
- (e) We do not serve children under the age of 10 years old after 10 pm. We will identify the children and, if possible, inform their parents in the first instance that their children have been out and about in the night in those hours. We will also record the names of the children and report them to the police.
