MANDATORY CONDITIONS

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence:
 - a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

- 3.—(1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
(2) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE

Alcohol may only be served for consumption off the premises.

Steps already in place to continue including spirits displayed behind the service counter, CCTV with recording facilities, full alarm system with panic buttons, fully trained staff with ongoing training regime, challenge 21 trading initiative with pass accredited proof of age scheme and refusals book plus staff training in the use of fire safety equipment.
