On New Year's Eve, except on a Sunday, 10.00 hours to 00.00 hours (midnight);  
On New Year's Eve on a Sunday, 12.00 hours (noon) to 23.30 hours  
On New Year's Eve from the end of permitted hours on New Year's Eve to the start of permitted hours on the following day (or, if there are no permitted hours on the following day, 00.00 hours (midnight) on 31 December)

**The opening hours of the premises:**

15.00 – 19.00 Christmas Day  
For 20 minutes after last permitted alcohol sale.

**MANDATORY CONDITIONS**

Premises Licence No: AT/PR/CV100QU/02/50351

The above restrictions do not prohibit:

- a) during the first twenty minutes after the above hours the consumption of the alcohol on the premises;
- b) during the first twenty minutes after the above hours, the taking of the alcohol from the premises unless the alcohol is supplied or taken in an open vessel;
- c) during the first thirty minutes after the above hours the consumption of the alcohol on the premises by persons taking meals there if the alcohol was supplied for consumption as ancillary to the meals;
- d) consumption of the alcohol on the premises or the taking of sale or supply of alcohol to any person residing in the premises.

Suitable non-alcoholic beverages, including drinking water, shall be equally available for consumption with or otherwise as an ancillary to meals served in the licensed premises.

The premises must be bona fide used for the purpose of habitually providing the customary main meal at midday or in the evening, or both, for the accommodation of persons frequenting the premises.
