## MANDATORY CONDITIONS

The admission of children to the exhibition of any film is restricted by age classification awarded to the film by the British Board of Film Classification.

Where-

the film classification is not specified admission of children must be restricted in accordance with the recommendation of the licensing authority.

- "children" means under 18.

- (1) Where individuals are at the premises to carry out a security activity such as door supervision, each such individual must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.
- (2) But nothing in subsection (1) requires such a condition to be imposed:
  - (a) in respect of premises within paragraph (8)(3)(a) of Schedule 2 to the Private Security Industry Act 2001 (c12) (premises with premises licence authorising only plays or films), or
  - (b) in respect of premises in relation to-
    - (i) any occasion mentioned in paragraph 8(3)(b) or (c) of that Schedule (premises being used exclusively by club with club premises certificate, under a temporary event notice authorising plays or films or under a gaming licence), or
    - (ii) any occasion within paragraph 8(3)(d) of that Schedule (occasions prescribed by regulations under that Act).
- (3) For the purposes of this section:
  - (a) "security activity" means an activity to which paragraph 2 (1)(a) of that Schedule applies, and
  - (b) paragraph 8(5) of that Schedule (interpretation of references to an occasion) applies as it applies in relation to paragraph 8 of that Schedule

## CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE

- a) **General – all four objectives (b, c, d, e)** - All regulated entertainment to be approved by the Charity before performance. The venue will only be Let to a bonafide community organisations and professional performers. An officer or member of the charity to be present at the regulated entertainment. The centre will not open to the public after 22:00 on any day.
- b) **The Prevention of Crime and Disorder** – A member or officer of the charity to be present at all regulated entertainment. All entertainment to be approved by the Charity Board, only Let to bonafide community groups and professional performers.
- c) **Public Safety** – Fire Fighting Equipment and Alarm, provided and tested with regular fire drills carried out. Audience and Performers will not exceed permitted numbers. Announcements of Emergency Procedures prior to all public performances.
- d) **The Prevention of Public Nuisance** – No Alcohol will be sold. All performances will end by 22:00 hours, volume of music will be kept to a minimum.
- e) **The Protection of Children from Harm** – No alcohol will be served on the premises. There will be no Gaming Machines on the premises. No films or performances for restricted age groups will be shown. Groups involving children have CRB checked staff supervising and performances by children within permitted times.
