**MANDATORY CONDITIONS**

No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence:

- a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
- b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.

Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied unless it is paid for before or at the time when it is sold or supplied, except alcohol sold or supplied with and for consumption at a meal supplied at the same time, consumed with the meal and paid for together with the meal.

**CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE**

The premises are part of a small chain owned by the applicant which is primarily food orientated and has various policies in place as outlined below to achieve the 4 licensing objectives. There is always a senior duty manager present when the premises are open so that supervision is always available.

There is good visibility from a centrally located bar area. There is waitress service of food throughout the premises even in the outside terrace area and all areas are constantly patrolled by staff and the duty manager. There is a strict no drinking policy for all staff and management who are therefore always fully alert. The premises have the benefit of an alarm system. A senior staff member is resident on the premises.

As a member of a small chain of public houses, the premises have a health and safety and food safety policy comprising a system professionally established by Environmental Health Systems Limited. The system is regularly reviewed and updated and an appropriate manual retained on the premises. A senior staff member in the chain regularly attends to train the staff in relevant matters.

The only music provided at the premises is incidental music, which is unlikely to cause any public nuisance. Late night patrons will be encouraged to leave the premises quietly.

There is regular supervision throughout the premises at all times as outlined above. Unaccompanied children are even now not permitted on the premises as a matter of policy and the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003 will be complied with. Customers with children will be encouraged to utilise the dining area of the premises rather than the bar. Notices are posted prohibiting under age drinking.

The permitted hours are extended as follows:-

On the Monday follow Bank Holiday weekends until 01.00.

On Christmas Eve and Boxing Day 10.00 – 02.00

On Good Friday 12.00 – 01.00

Christmas Day 12.00 – 15.00 & 19.00 – 22.30

From 10.00 New Year's Eve (31/12) – 01.00 (2/1)

When extended hours are used the closing time for the premises will be 30 minutes after last permitted licensable activity.
