Prevention of Crime and Disorder

We do not supply alcohol. We have security lights outside and a burglar alarm inside. Events are family orientated and functions are supervised by committee members.

Public Safety

Capacity 100.

Hall age approximately 15 years old. Floor size of main hall is approximately 150 square metres with two fire exits. Fire exits situated on ground floor at front and at side next to kitchen and at rear by changing rooms. Licence activities include music and dancing and take place occasionally (4 to 6 times per year). Age range is young children through to old age pensioners including disabled. It is not envisaged that special effects will be used. Alarm tested annually under a maintenance contract. Emergency lighting is tested periodically.

Prevention of Public Nuisance

The location of the premises is such that there will be little or no impact on local residential homes, being 150 metres from the nearest house. At any time there is only a maximum of 100 people on the site and functions rarely exceed 6 per annum.

Protection of Children from Harm

We aim to be a family orientated organisation. Our functions are family events and children are accompanied by parents or other responsible adults. Committee members all live locally and know the children.
