MANDATORY CONDITIONS

No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence:

- a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
- b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.

Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Intoxicating liquor shall not be sold or supplied on the premises otherwise than to persons taking table meals there and for the consumption by such a person as an ancillary to his meal. Suitable beverages other than intoxicating liquor (including drinking water) shall be equally available for consumption with or otherwise as an ancillary to meals served on the premises.

CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE

Children up to 16 years of age will be supervised at all times. They will not be exposed to any dangers and will not be allowed to roam freely out of sight.

We have joined a scheme with North Warwickshire Police (Pub Watch) along with a number of other licensed premises. Where a member of the public is barred from one premises that member is barred from all member premises participating in the scheme.

Alcohol will not be served to drunk and/or disorderly members of public. Minors will be refused service.

Alcohol will only be served as part of a meal and can only be consumed on the premises. No off-sales are permitted.

Being members of the scheme has greatly reduced the trouble makers and the area on the night time is generally of a more calm and trouble free atmosphere. The vibe in the restaurant us nice and calm, where children would feel at ease. Any member of the public whom look under the drinking age limit will be refused sale of alcohol unless identification is provided, in the form of a photo driving licence, passport or proof of age card.
