MANDATORY CONDITIONS

Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied unless it is paid for before or at the time when it is sold or supplied, except alcohol sold or supplied with and for consumption at a meal supplied at the same time, consumed with the meal and paid for together with the meal.

The Club rules and constitution govern the operation of this Club Premises Certificate.

Any club premises certificate that authorises the supply of alcohol:

- 1) The supply of alcohol must be made when the premises are open for the purposes of supplying alcohol, in accordance with the club certificate, to members of the club for consumption on the premises.
- 2) Any alcohol supplied for consumption off the premises must be in a sealed container.
- 3) Any supply of alcohol for consumption off the premises must be made to a member of the club in person.

CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE CLUB OPERATING SCHEDULE

CCTV surveillance on entry door. Swipe card system access for members and guests. Club management, steward and bar staff are informed of the Licensing Act 2003 objectives and statutory requirements to comply with all relevant provisions of the Act. Car parking area and rear of the club are floodlit.

Club constitution includes rules governing the conduct of members and their guests within and adjacent to the Club premises. Admission to the Club is confined to members and guests controlled through a door entry system. Guests arriving unaccompanied are scrutinised via CCTV before admission and signed in by host member. Club employees are instructed not to admit or serve members and guests who behave in a drunk and disorderly manner. Misconduct is reported to the committee to consider action under the Club's disciplinary code.

The Club complies with Health & Safety precaution regulations. Following Risk Assessment, preventative and control measures are in place to ensure the safety of members, guests, employees and entertainers while on the premises. The Club complies with advised capacity limits. Fire action notices are posted, emergency escape routes are signposted and covered by emergency lighting. Fire alarms and emergency lights are tested regularly.

Signage is displayed near exits requesting members and guests to respect the needs of local residents by quietly leaving the premises and car park. When live or recorded music is played all reasonable steps are taken to avoid disturbance to neighbouring properties.

Persons under the age of 18 are only allowed in the club if accompanied by an adult member. Door control system ensures that children seeking admission for any purpose are accompanied by an adult. Young adults applying for membership must satisfy the committee that they are over 18, if necessary proof of age will be asked for. Accompanied children may attend a private party in the function room. Committee, club steward and bar staff are instructed in the offence provisions of the Licensing Act 2003 relating to alcohol and the protection of children. Signage is posted prohibiting the direct or indirect supply and delivery of alcohol to children.
