MANDATORY CONDITIONS

Any club premises certificate that authorises the supply of alcohol:

- 1) The supply of alcohol must be made when the premises are open for the purposes of supplying alcohol, in accordance with the club certificate, to members of the club for consumption on the premises.
- 2) Any alcohol supplied for consumption off the premises must be in a sealed container.
- 3) Any supply of alcohol for consumption off the premises must be made to a member of the club in person.

The admission of children to the exhibition of any film is restricted by age classification awarded to the film by the British Board of Film Classification.

Where-

The film classification is not specified admission of children must be restricted in accordance with the recommendation of the licensing authority.

- **“children” means under 18.**

Conditions consistent with Operating Schedule

General

Club has rules of association governing the behaviour of members. Members sign in guests. At all times the club endeavours to operate within legal boundaries without causing any unnecessary burden.

Prevention of Crime and Disorder

Burglar Alarm fitted, CCTV installed and available to police. Metal grids on windows and doors. Door locking access system being installed to front door with CCTV facial recognition.

Public Safety

Annual fire extinguisher checks and alarm testing. All emergency exits clearly marked. Risk assessments on access/egress, COSHH, lifting and slipping. Capacity is 270, but for comfort set by club at 200.

Prevention of Public Nuisance

Signs saying leave quietly. Control over misbehaving members. Size of the premises dictates the number of persons attending and the type of entertainment booked.

Protection of Children from Harm

Children allowed with responsible adult only. AWP viewed from bar so no under 18's can play. NO intentions to have adult entertainment. Intentions – after 21:00 only. NO children allowed in the club after 21:00 on specified occasions if ever applicable.

The Club rules and constitution govern the operation of this Club Premises Certificate.
