The times the certificate authorises the carrying out of qualifying club activities:

Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied except during permitted hours.

In this condition, permitted hours means:

- a) On weekdays, other than Christmas Day, Good Friday or New Year's Eve, 10.00 hours to 23.00 hours
- b) On Sundays, other than Christmas Day or New Year's Eve, 12.00 hours (noon) to 22.30 hours
- c) On Good Friday, 12.00 hours (noon) to 22.30 hours
- d) On New Year's Eve, except on a Sunday, 10.00 hours to 23.00 hours
- e) On New Year's Eve on a Sunday, 12.00 hours (noon) to 22.30 hours
- f) On New Year's Eve from the end of permitted hours to the start of permitted hours on the following day (or, if there are no permitted hours on the following day, 00.00 hours (midnight) on 31 December)
- g) On Christmas Day said hours shall be in accordance with the Club rules but
 - 1 not exceed six and a half hours;
 - 2 not begin earlier than 12.00 hours (noon);
 - 3 not end later than 22.30 hours
 - 4 provide for a break of at least 2 hours, including 15.00 hours to 17.00 hours;
 - 5 not extend for more than three and a half hours after 17.00 hours

The opening hours of the club:

For 20 minutes after last permitted alcohol supply

Where the certificate authorises supplies of alcohol whether these are on and/or off supplies:

MANDATORY CONDITIONS

Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied except during permitted hours.
In this condition, permitted hours means:

- h) On weekdays, other than Christmas Day, Good Friday or New Year's Eve, 10.00 hours to 23.00 hours
- i) On Sundays, other than Christmas Day or New Year's Eve, 12.00 hours (noon) to 22.30 hours
- j) On Good Friday, 12.00 hours (noon) to 22.30 hours
- k) On New Year's Eve, except on a Sunday, 10.00 hours to 23.00 hours
- l) On New Year's Eve on a Sunday, 12.00 hours (noon) to 22.30 hours
- m) On New Year's Eve from the end of permitted hours to the start of permitted hours on the following day (or, if there are no permitted hours on the following day, 00.00 hours (midnight) on 31 December)
- n) On Christmas Day said hours shall be in accordance with the Club rules but
 - 6 not exceed six and a half hours;
 - 7 not begin earlier than 12.00 hours (noon);
 - 8 not end later than 22.30 hours
 - 9 provide for a break of at least 2 hours, including 15.00 hours to 17.00 hours;
 - 10 not extend for more than three and a half hours after 17.00 hours

The above restrictions do not prohibit:

- a) during the first twenty minutes after the above hours, the consumption of the alcohol on the premises;
- b) during the first twenty minutes after the above hours, the taking of alcohol from the premises, unless the alcohol is supplied or taken in an open vessel;
- c) during the first thirty minutes after the above hours, the consumption of the alcohol on the premises by persons taking meals there if the alcohol was supplied as ancillary to the meals;
- d) the supply to, or consumption by, any person of alcohol in any premises where they are residing.

The Club rules and constitution govern the operation of this Club Premises Certificate.

Any club premises certificate that authorises the supply of alcohol:

- 1) The supply of alcohol must be made when the premises are open for the purposes of supplying alcohol, in accordance with the club certificate, to members of the club for consumption on the premises.
- 2) Any alcohol supplied for consumption off the premises must be in a sealed container.
- 3) Any supply of alcohol for consumption off the premises must be made to a member of the club in person.

CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE CLUB OPERATING SCHEDULE

The CPC authorises supply of alcohol, not entertainment.
