MANDATORY CONDITIONS

Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied unless it is paid for before or at the time when it is sold or supplied, except alcohol sold or supplied with and for consumption at a meal supplied at the same time, consumed with the meal and paid for together with the meal.

The Club rules and constitution govern the operation of this Club Premises Certificate.

Any club premises certificate that authorises the supply of alcohol:

- 1) The supply of alcohol must be made when the premises are open for the purposes of supplying alcohol, in accordance with the club certificate, to members of the club for consumption on the premises.
- 2) Any alcohol supplied for consumption off the premises must be in a sealed container.
- 3) Any supply of alcohol for consumption off the premises must be made to a member of the club in person.

CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE CLUB OPERATING SCHEDULE

All our staff and committee have been instructed of the objectives and statutory requirements to comply with the relevant provisions of the Licensing Act 2003.

Our rules include rules governing the conduct of members and their guests in the club and the surrounding grounds adjacent to the club.

Admission to the club is restricted to members and bona fide guests. Members of the committee regularly police any function in the function room and in the grounds surrounding the club. Any person misbehaving or drunk would be asked to leave the premises and the committee would take the appropriate action under the club rules.

The club complies with the Health & Safety and Fire Precautions regulations. Preventative and control measures are in place to ensure the safety of anyone on the premises. The club complies strictly with the advised capacity limits. Fire action notices are posted; emergency escape routes are sign-posted.

Concert room capacity is 150 people

Bar area room capacity is 80 people

We as a Club will not let the rooms in excess these capacities at any times.

Signs are posted throughout the Club requesting members and their guests to leave the Club and grounds in an orderly fashion in respect for our neighbours. When live or recorded music is played all reasonable steps are taken to avoid disturbance to our neighbours. When any function takes place the committee ensure that all outside doors are kept closed to reduce the noise.

Persons under the age of 18 are only allowed in the Club if they are accompanied by an adult. The committee and bar staff ensure that no one under the age of 18 enters the Club unaccompanied. Notices are posted throughout the Club that ID will be asked for and Committee and bar staff reserve the right to refuse to serve alcohol to anyone they consider to be under age. Also signs are all around the Club to ensure all children are supervised at all times.

Licensable activities are permitted on Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, Boxing Day and New Year's Day 11.00 – 01.00

New Year's Eve 11.00 – 02.30

Nothing in these conditions permits the use of premises for anything other than Club members or their bona fide guests. All reference to private parties are construed as members or their bona fide guests in accordance with the Club rules on guests.
