MANDATORY CONDITIONS

Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied unless it is paid for before or at the time when it is sold or supplied, except alcohol sold or supplied with and for consumption at a meal supplied at the same time, consumed with the meal and paid for together with the meal.

Any club premises certificate that authorises the supply of alcohol:

- 1) The supply of alcohol must be made when the premises are open for the purposes of supplying alcohol, in accordance with the club certificate, to members of the club for consumption on the premises.
- 2) Any alcohol supplied for consumption off the premises must be in a sealed container.
- 3) Any supply of alcohol for consumption off the premises must be made to a member of the club in person.

CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE CLUB OPERATING SCHEDULE

The Club rules and constitution govern the operation of this Club Premises Certificate.

There is, installed, an internal CCTV system. Due to the nature of the Club and its members, there is no history of crime and disorder. However, the committee will deal with any such incident within the rules of the Club, including suspension or expulsion. Bar staff receive appropriate training.

This Club has run for many years with little problem in respect of the licensing objectives. When there has been, as on one occasion, a complaint about noise it was dealt with and the offending doors were kept closed when music was playing. The Club has its own rules which are, in part, designed to promote the licensing objectives. Discipline is governed by the Committee and there is accountability of members.

The Club adheres to the recommendations of the Fire Officer as to occupant capacity, namely 200 in the main room and 170 in the function room. There are four first aid kits on the premises. There is ample seating in the main rooms. There are regular inspections by the Fire Officer and recommendations are followed.

The Club premises will be vacated within 30 minutes of the times shown in L. In the function room the windows do not open so as to reduce noise levels outside. In addition the Club keeps doors closed (save for persons entering and leaving) in the function room for the same reason. The Club will display notices asking for members consideration to neighbouring properties when leaving the premises.

Children are to be accompanied by adults, and persons under 18 are not entitled to purchase or consume alcohol. Due to the nature of the Club and its members there is a high level of supervision of any children on the premises.

The CPC authorises licensable activities beyond the permitted hours overleaf as follows:

Supply of Alcohol

Bank Holidays 11.00 – 00.00

Christmas Eve 11.00 – 00.00

New Years Eve 11.00 – 00.30

On these occasions regulated entertainment to cease 15 minutes before the last permitted alcohol supply.

On no more than 12 occasions per year live or recorded music can take place on the premises between 1700 and 15 minutes prior to the last permitted alcohol supply.
