MANDATORY CONDITIONS

Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied unless it is paid for before or at the time when it is sold or supplied, except alcohol sold or supplied with and for consumption at a meal supplied at the same time, consumed with the meal and paid for together with the meal.

Exemptions

The hours during which licensable activities are permitted are shown overleaf with the exception of

Good Friday 12.00 – 22.30 only

New Years Eve from 1100 until normal closing time on New Years Day

Christmas Day – any period which does not exceed 6½ hours 12.00 – 22.30 providing a break of 2 hours between 03.00 – 17.00 and not extend more than 3½ hours after 17.00

Bank Holiday Mondays regulated entertainment until 0100 following – indoors and 2300 outdoors

Any club premises certificate that authorises the supply of alcohol:

- 1) The supply of alcohol must be made when the premises are open for the purposes of supplying alcohol, in accordance with the club certificate, to members of the club for consumption on the premises.
- 2) Any alcohol supplied for consumption off the premises must be in a sealed container.
- 3) Any supply of alcohol for consumption off the premises must be made to a member of the club in person.

CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE CLUB OPERATING SCHEDULE

Sale of alcohol for consumption off the premises is only to be made to club members during hours when the club is open for consumption on the premises all off sales to be in sealed containers.

All members issued with membership cards. Guests must sign in. Consumption of alcohol only in specified areas. No taking out of open containers.

Current Fire Safety Standards. Safety check once a month with a log book of any concerns/incidents.

All outdoor drinking and music to stop at 2300. 2300 – 2400 all doors and windows closed. A sign on leaving club asking everyone to respect neighbours and leave quietly.

Proof of age cards. Membership cards different colour for under 18's. No children under 16 after 9 pm at club unless accompanied by an adult. The club has a Child Protection Policy.
