MANDATORY CONDITIONS

Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied unless it is paid for before or at the time when it is sold or supplied, except alcohol sold or supplied with and for consumption at a meal supplied at the same time, consumed with the meal and paid for together with the meal.

The Club rules and constitution govern the operation of this Club Premises Certificate.

Any club premises certificate that authorises the supply of alcohol:

- 1) The supply of alcohol must be made when the premises are open for the purposes of supplying alcohol, in accordance with the club certificate, to members of the club for consumption on the premises.
- 2) Any alcohol supplied for consumption off the premises must be in a sealed container.
- 3) Any supply of alcohol for consumption off the premises must be made to a member of the club in person.

CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE CLUB OPERATING SCHEDULE

The Club has acquainted its committee, steward and staff with the objectives and requirements of the Licensing Act 2003 to ensure all provisions relevant to the running of a club are complied with. The Club is responsibly managed by a committee and a constitution and rules complying with the relevant sections of the Licensing Act 1964 governing clubs. The Club is registered with the F.S.A.

The Club rules govern the conduct of members both on and off the club premises and the club strictly enforces its disciplinary procedures, including suspension and expulsion. Details of guests of members are entered in a guest book. The steward and staff are instructed not to admit or serve members or guests who behave in a drunken, disorderly or anti-social fashion.

The Club complies with Health & Safety and Fire Precaution Regulations. The Club's registration certificate was renewed on 12 August 2003 when the relevant authorities were served with a copy of the application and a full fire service inspection was carried out and procedures updated to their satisfaction. Fire action notices are posted and emergency escape routes signposted.

Care is taken when members are leaving the Club to ensure neighbours are not disturbed. See Para (b). When live or recorded music is played all reasonable steps are taken to ensure noise levels are set so as to avoid disturbance to neighbouring properties.

Persons under 18 years of age are only allowed in the Club if accompanied by an adult member or guest. No-one under 18 years of age is allowed to purchase alcohol. If age is in doubt then the steward or staff will require authentic proof of age. The committee and staff ensure that no-one under 18 engages in any gaming activities within the Club and there are notices on AWP machines saying "No-one under 18 is allowed to play these machines".

The Club Premises Certificate authorises licensable activities beyond these times overleaf as follows:-

Bank Holiday Weekends on Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays & Mondays 11.00 – 00.00.

Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, Boxing Day, New Year's Eve & New Year's Day 11.00 – 00.30.
