MANDATORY CONDITIONS

Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied unless it is paid for before or at the time when it is sold or supplied, except alcohol sold or supplied with and for consumption at a meal supplied at the same time, consumed with the meal and paid for together with the meal.

Any club premises certificate that authorises the supply of alcohol:

- 1) The supply of alcohol must be made when the premises are open for the purposes of supplying alcohol, in accordance with the club certificate, to members of the club for consumption on the premises.
- 2) Any alcohol supplied for consumption off the premises must be in a sealed container.
- 3) Any supply of alcohol for consumption off the premises must be made to a member of the club in person.

CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE CLUB OPERATING SCHEDULE

The Club rules and constitution govern the operation of this Club Premises Certificate.

The Certificate permits the licensable activity to be carried on beyond the hours stated overleaf as follows:

Christmas Eve and Boxing Day 11.00 – 00.00

Christmas Day – 11.00 – 13.00 & 19.00 – 23.00

New Years Eve – 11.00 – 02.30

New Years Day 11.00 – 00.00

Bank Holiday Weekends Saturday, Sunday, Monday 11.00 – 00.00.

Club management and bar staff are informed of the Licensing Act 2003 objectives and statutory requirements to comply with all relevant provisions of the Act.

The Club constitution includes rules governing the conduct of members and their guests within and adjacent to the club premises. Admission to the club is confined to members and bona fide guests and controlled by a signing in system. Club employees are instructed not to admit or serve members and guests who behave in a drunk and disorderly fashion. Misconduct is reported to the committee to consider under the Club's disciplinary code.

The Club complies with Health and Safety and Fire Precautions. Following risk assessment and control measures are in place to ensure the safety of members, guests, employees and entertainers while on the premises. The club complies with advised capacity limits. Fire action notices are posted: emergency escape routes are signposted.

Signage is displayed near exits requesting members and guests to respect the needs of local residents by quietly leaving the premises and car park. When live or recorded music is played all reasonable steps are taken to avoid disturbance to neighbouring properties.

The Certificate authorises licensable activities to members and bona fide guests. Private parties are not authorised on this C P Certificate and separate authorisation will be needed either by premises Licence or Temporary Event Notice.
