North Warwickshire Borough Council Local Plan

Further to Section 5 of the Transport and Highways Statement of Common Ground (SoCG) between North Warwickshire Borough Council (NWBC), Warwickshire County Council (WCC) and Highways England, informing the North Warwickshire Local Plan Examination in Public (EiP), we can confirm that Highways England has now reviewed traffic analysis work on the A5 corridor that further clarifies the implications of the two neighbouring Borough Plans and associated growth.

We consider that the extensive modelling undertaken to date for the Local Plan provides an appropriate transport evidence base for the Plan and for the associated Infrastructure Delivery Plan. We have raised some issues with the modelling and these will be relevant should it be intended to use the current model to assess detailed scheme options and inform the preparation of business cases for investment.

Given the above, our latest review of the modelling reinforces our overall position regarding to the North Warwickshire Borough Local Plan and as such we do not intend to attend the EiP unless otherwise requested.
