### **Priorities**

- Nuisance Ansley Common (Bretts Hall) Recreation Ground (agreed 25 targeted patrols)
- Parking Issues, Bourne Brook School, Fillongley (agreed 20 targeted patrols)
- Speeding Furnace End, B4098 (agreed 10 targeted patrols)

## **Community Priorities**

- Warwickshire Police is obliged to protect communities from harm in line with the 'Police Priorities'.
- This may mean that in exceptional circumstances SNT officers may be required to work on other policing priorities.
- If this happens there will be a need to re-negotiate priorities. This will be done in liaison with the Chair and the panel.

## **Anti-Social Behaviour Ansley Common**

- Target of 25 patrols achieved 33
- Dec to Feb 14 calls but 11 of these were silent 9's. Feb to June there were 22 calls
- worked with NWBC and Youth Services and visited potential offenders
- With Councillors help diaries distributed to accurately record incidents
- Young people in the vicinity have been spoken to and advised about acceptable behaviour and given road safety advice
- A third party statement of evidence has been obtained

## ASB – Recreation ground, Ansley Common.

•NWBC have funded the installation of a column and a mobile infra red CCTV camera. Ongoing issues with positioning which are being resolved.

•Green space consultants are investigating opportunities for the future enhancement of the recreation ground. Public consultation due this summer, anticipated draft plans will be available in the Autumn




# Solomon anti-social behaviour and alcohol awareness workshop.

- •93% of students understand more about how alcohol effects their decisions
- •77% of students stated they are responsible for their actions after they have drank alcohol
- •61% understand the effects of alcohol on their health following the presentation;
- •27% of the students stated they would drink less alcohol
- 34% said they do not drink •10% were unsure
- •22% said they would drink the same amount

- •Identified hotspot locations will have signage and will receive freepost postcards




## Nuisance motorcycle
