
## **Community Priorities**

## Safer Neighbourhoods

- -High St/ Birmingham Rd, Coleshill, Target of 20 patrols
- •30 targeted patrols conducted.
- •Enhanced Policing of Coleshill town centre on 11 evenings/ nights. Particular attention paid the licensed premises.
- •Liaison with licensed premises on lead up to Christmas period, including extra patrols by PCSO's.
- •As a result there have been a low incidents of assaults in the Coleshill area, (details as follows).
- •20/10/10 31/10/10 2 assaults Coleshill North.
- •01/11/10 30/11/10 2 assaults Coleshill Town.
- •01/12/10 31/12/10 1 robbery personal Coleshill Town
- •01/01/11 12/01/11 No offences recorded.

# ASB – Ansley Common (evenings and weekends) Target of 20 patrols

- •25 targeted patrols conducted.
- •No problems encountered.
- No reports of ASB in area reported during period.
- Fence completed around the allotment site

## **Speeding – Gun Hill, Arley**

#### Target of 12 speed checks

- •13 speed checks conducted.
- •512 vehicles had speed checked as a result.
- •No evidence of speeding found, one driver advised.

## Speeding other – Community Speed Watch

- •Regarding the scheme in Over Whitacre vetting forms have been returned and training is to be organised.
- •Regarding scheme in Ansley Vetting forms have been submitted for checks.
