2018 Parliamentary Boundary Review

1 Summary

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to consider whether the Council wishes to respond to the representations received in respect of the Boundary Commission's 2018 Parliamentary Boundary Review for North Warwickshire.

Recommendation to the Council

That the Council responds to the representations received in respect of the Boundary Commission's 2018 Parliamentary Boundary Review for North Warwickshire.

2 Report

- 2.1 Last year, the Boundary Commission for England published and consulted on initial proposals for new Parliamentary Constituency Boundaries. Details of the proposals were circulated to all Members.
- 2.2 Nearly 20,000 responses were received by the Boundary Commission for England to that consultation. The next stage of the 2018 Review is that the Boundary Commission for England has published all those representations and invited comments on them for the statutory four-week period, until Monday 27 March 2017. All representations have been published on its website at www.bce2018.org.uk, where you can search by a number of different options, such as name, reference number, existing constituency or type of respondent, as well as using the interactive mapping system to locate comments geographically. A number of representations have been received in respect of North Warwickshire.

3 Next Steps

- 3.1 Following the secondary consultation, the Commission will be considering all representations received from both consultations, and will consider whether any revisions are needed. If it decides to revise the proposals, it will consult on the revised boundaries. The Commission expects any such consultation to happen towards the end of 2017, or in early 2018.
