Acoustic screening installed around noisier plant machinery

Operating hours of the site has been reduced

Vehicle queuing significantly reduced

## **ISSUE 5**

Obstructive Parking – Long Leys Croft, Water Orton

## **OUTCOME**

Road is not a public highway. WCC can not introduce parking restrictions

Need to contact land agent to see if there's a covenant restricting parking

## **ISSUE 6**

HGV movements through Lea Marston - update

## **OUTCOME**

Transport Projects, WCC awaiting confirmation of funding before ordering signs to bring weight limit signage up to standard and enforceable
