- Inconsiderate parking Market Street / Church Street, Atherstone Town Centre
- Off road motorcycles using Hartshill Hayes

5. George Eliot Hospital – outcome from Keogh Review & sustainability future project

R Herd, Non-executive director, George Eliot Hospital (GEH) gave an update. Keogh inspection recommended an increase in pace of improvements towards operating a full seven day a week service.

Approval granted by NHS Trust Development Agency for the hospital to seek a partner organisation to secure a sustainable future for GEH Paediatric day care provision has increased with 10 full time equivalent paediatricians employed. There is no longer an inpatient paediatric service Friends & family independent survey has revealed that 84% of patients are extremely likely to recommend GEH services.

Concern that families are not being kept informed of patients' condition Request to keep public up to date on progress to secure a partner by March 2015 Comments & complaints by the public about GEH can be made to Security Board, (Health & Public Care), NWBC.
