PACT Priorities

- Parking and congestion issues Ratcliffe Road, Atherstone near to Doctors Surgery (agreed 25 targeted patrols)
- Parking and congestion issues at Junction of Arden Street and South Street Atherstone (agreed 25 targeted patrols)
 - Parking and congestion issues at school times Victoria Road and Church Road Hartshill (agreed 25 targeted patrols)

Community Priorities

- Warwickshire Police is obliged to protect communities from harm in line with the 'Police Priorities'.
- This may mean that in exceptional circumstances SNT officers may be required to work on other policing priorities.
- If this happens there will be a need to re-negotiate priorities. This will be done in liaison with the Chair and the panel.

Parking Ratcliffe Road Doctors Surgery

- 70 targeted patrols completed (25 agreed)
- Notices placed on illegally parked vehicles by PCSO's
- Worked closely with Ratcliffe Road Doctors Surgery notices placed in prominent locations in surgery
- 5 fixed penalty notices issued to drivers
- Arranged contact with pharmaceutical and shredding companies
- Arranged for double yellow lines to be repainted
- Worked closely with Atherstone Hall Estate Residents Association
- Speed checks conducted Ratcliffe Road

Parking and congestion issues Junction of Arden Street and South Street Atherstone

- 67 targeted patrols/checks completed (25 agreed)
- all residents of Arden Street formally visited by police and issued with written instruction regarding this priority
- PCSO's issued warning notices on all vehicles parked at junction
- worked with Arden Hill Social Services and produced parking information for display
- 3 fixed penalty tickets issued to vehicles parked at junction
- targeted patrols at various times/days
- maintained contact/update with local residents

School Parking/congestion issues Victoria Road/Church Road

- 46 patrols conducted (25 agreed)
- PCSO's issued warning notices to illegally parked vehicles
- 9 fixed penalty notices issued
- both morning and end of school day times targeted
- continued engagement with Hartshill school pupils through schools PCSO
- engagement with buses and schools including Michael Drayton School reference buses and turning circle
- engagement with residents of Church Close and Victoria Road
- awaiting details of budget for allocation to long term engineering solution

Other Work

Safer Neighbourhoods

- ongoing development and support of active NHW groups proactive groups growing in membership in East area
- ongoing success of shopwatch in Atherstone town centre with 5 local shoplifters now banned from all member stores
- continued disruption of known offenders in area involving execution of successful drugs warrants and arrest of high profile offenders
- increased work within schools via PCSO placement
- joint work with trading standards and council to prosecute licensed premises for serving underage, series of further licensing checks conducted
- increased emphasis on supporting vulnerable victims of ASB and action planning problem areas
- continued targeting of off road motorcycles
- new Atherstone town centre PCSO 6207 Liz UDALL

North Warwickshire Community Safety Partnership

- Nomad 3g mobile cctv being implemented
- Images can be viewed via a lap top within the SNT offices in Old Bank House
- Lister Road shops deployment has been changed to a Nomad camera
- 8 Nomads and 8 Domehawk cameras currently deployed across the borough

North Warwickshire Community Safety Partnership

- Strategic Assessment 2013/14 draft priorities to be considered by the partnership
- Violent Crime with a focus on town centre alcohol related violence, domestic related violence and older people as victims of crime. Offender management to concentrate on young people as offenders

North Warwickshire Community Safety Partnership

- Anti Social Behaviour with a focus on alcohol and youth related
- Serious Acquisitive Crime with a focus on domestic burglary and to maintain cross border offender management
- Reducing Reoffending to prioritise the offenders of domestic burglary and vehicle crime
