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What is Extra Care Housing?

- Live at home, not in a home
- Support in maintaining independence
- Your own front door!
- Couples can stay together
- Mixed tenure schemes
- Mix of low, medium and high level care needs
- 24-hour care and support as needed
- Telecare (or Assistive Technology) available
- Social activities available
- Safer and more secure



Current Position

- Need to change balance of care
- Demographic change!
- 'Housing with Care' is still limited
- Initial Older People focus
- Learning Disability services also progressing
- Partnerships with boroughs and districts
- 'Windfall' opportunities



What is WCC delivering

- First contract awarded in 2009 21 units
- Briar Croft, Stratford-upon-Avon– 64 units
- Farmers Court, Rugby 45 units
- Partnership Framework contract in place
- Two 'mini-competitions' to date
- Warwick award to Housing 21 in 2010
- 6 Sites approved by Cabinet and Council
- Award to Housing 21 in August 2011
- 2 x LD schemes contracts awarded

- Rugby 61 units
- Bedworth (x 2) 85 units
- Alcester 45 units
- Stratford–upon-Avon 102 units
