Safer Neighbourhood Priorities

- Parking issues Atherstone town centre (15 targeted patrols)
- ASB Coleshill Road, Chapel End (25 targeted patrols)
- Underage Drinking Atherstone town centre (10 targeted patrols)

- Warwickshire Police is obliged to protect communities from harm in line with the 'Police Priorities'.
- This may mean that in exceptional circumstances SNT officers may be required to work on other policing priorities.
- If this happens there will be a need to re-negotiate priorities.

Parking Issues – Atherstone town centre

(15 patrols = 100% agreed Policing activity)

- 57 targeted patrols conducted.
- 48 Fixed Penalty tickets issued to drivers (total £1440 in fines).
- 93 drivers warned regarding parking offences.
- Engaged with every shop/business on Long Street in respect of parking. Flyers and posters delivered explaining the drive to tackle the illegal parking.
- Press release front page of Atherstone Herald (25/08/11).
- PCSO warning ticket system improved and updated.
- Record maintained of warnings issued. No repeat offenders identified.

(25 patrols = 100% agreed Policing activity)

- 77 targeted patrols conducted utilising all resources at different times/days.
- •Licensing checks completed on The Chase, Supermart, and Hartshill Club. Challenge 21 policy enforced.
- The Chase visited repeatedly and engagement with all staff. Consideration given to drugs dog. Intelligence work completed.
- •Trading standards checks completed on The Chase, Supermart and Costcutter.
- •Work completed with local schools in relation to ASB/drugs/underage drinking.

Underage Drinking Atherstone town centre

(10 patrols = 100% agreed Policing activity)

- 73 targeted patrols completed.
- Continuation of previous work further repeated visits to all licensees. Challenge 21 policy enforced.
- 8 Licensing checks completed (police).
- 4 Licensing checks completed (police and licensing officer)
 1 breach of conditions identified.
- 5 Trading standards checks completed (with licensing officer) 1 licensed premises prosecuted for selling underage.

Other Work

- •Continued emphasis on setting up neighbourhood watch schemes. 3 more established.
- •Emphasis placed on policing local high profile offenders resulting in several significant arrests. 2 ABC's issued.
- Continuation of graffiti clean up (3 visits).
- Continuation of work in local schools to address issues of ASB, drugs, underage drinking.
- •Further community engagement days in Atherstone. Ongoing work with British Waterways/off road team.
- •2 cannabis hydroponics plants located and offenders prosecuted.
