## **NOTES TO HELP YOU**

## Classes of person(s) to be Disregarded for the Purposes of Council Tax Discount

i) Apprentice/ Y.T.S. Trainee:

An apprentice is a person who is undertaking a programme of training leading to a qualification accredited by the National Council for Vocational Qualification for the purpose of learning a trade, business, profession, office, employment or vocation. An apprentice must not earn more than £160 per week prior to 1st April 2007, and must not earn more than £195 per week

A youth training trainee is a person under 25 who is undertaking a training course under Section 2 of the Employment and Training Act 1973 which is approved for the purposes of Section 28 of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits Act 1992.
